2011 Lou Gerber Scholarships
for OSEA Members



The Oregon School Employees Association (OSEA) sponsors two \$1,000 scholarships in each of the seven zones for OSEA members to further their education in an accredited school.

Applicants must be OSEA members in good standing as of December 31, 2010.

OSEA members wanting to continue their education, or without a high school diploma but desiring to get their graduation equivalence degree (GED), are encouraged to apply for this scholarship.

Applicants will be accepted on the following criteria:

- A brief statement, **not to exceed 150 words**, describing your educational interests, plans and activities (inside and outside of school/work).
- Answer the two questions (provided on the application form) regarding your involvement and experience with OSEA. Answer must **not exceed 300 words**.
- **Attach two references** that include a brief statement about you. **One of these references must be from an OSEA member.**
- The application must be postmarked on or before **February 1, 2011.**

Scholarship funds must be used within three years **or by the fall of 2014.**

The scholarship recipients will be notified in the spring of 2011. They will be asked to submit a photo and brief biographical information to be published in the *OSEA Journal*.
